As you may be aware, we recently welcomed Ofsted for an unannounced monitoring visit in May. I am pleased to share that the final report is now available and can be accessed via the Our School section of our website.

We are heartened by the progress recognised in the report and encouraged by the acknowledgement that our plans and actions are *on track*. While we know that there is still more work to do, it is clear that the improvements we are making are beginning to have a positive impact on the experience and safety of our students.
