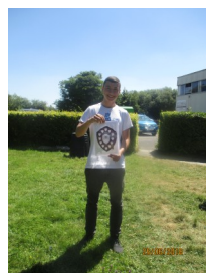
Wow!! What an amazing year!! Westbury continues to grow, welcoming new staff and students throughout the year.
