Jane our Head Teacher has been completing a 10 day training course to become an adolescent Thrive practitioner. This is a key element of the way we work with all of our children and underpins the culture of the school. The Thrive Approach draws from neuroscience, attachment theory and child development to provide a powerful way of working with young people that supports them to strengthen their social and emotional development. The Thrive Approach also equips staff to work in a targeted way with young people who may have struggled with difficult life events to help them re-engage with life and learning. Through small group and one to one work it allows young people to develop healthy, happy, confident attitudes and who are ready and open to learning. We are really fortunate to have also had the creative skills of Lisa who has completely refurbished the Thrive room with lots of sensory and stimulating resources.
